During a four-week intensive summer program, young people between the ages of 4 and 18 develop their talents in theatre, dance, music, and the visual arts, with a staff of dedicated professional artists and educators. KAT members broaden their experience and challenge their talents by performing in a series of choral, dance and musical theatre productions, as well as contributing to an extensive art exhibition.

1. KAT Chorus and KAT Dancers I & II and KAT Dance Intensive participants will perform before Youtheatre *Peter Pan* performances July 28-31.
2. Youtheatre performers will have an extra rehearsal Sunday, July 24. In addition, they will stay until 5 pm July 25-27 to prepare for the July 28-31 performances.
3. In order to enroll in fun Friday, you must also be enrolled in at least 1 other KAT class. Register for each Fun Friday class separately. Off-site activities may be added and may have additional fees.
4. All KAT Acting Intensive participants must be 10 years old by Summer 2011 and have completed previous KAT acting workshops or with permission of instructor.
5. All KAT Dance Intensive participants must be 10 years old by Summer 2011 with at least 5 years dance experience or with permission of instructor.
6. KAT Kabaret begins rehearsals prior to KAT and rehearses additional times throughout the first week of KAT in order to prepare for performances on July 7-10. A schedule of rehearsal times will be included with your confirmation letter.
